ONE YEAR OF WOBIS

It has been a year since the WOBIS project began. Many activities took place during this first year. After the Kick-off meeting in May 2022 Slovak the University Agriculture in Nitra organized by New Edu, the partnership met in October in Italy in Bovino, hosted by Meridaunia. The event was part of a three-day international networking event based on sustainable development and circular WOBIS economy. The project entered the contribution of gender equality in the new paradigm of sustainable development, which must embrace the three bottom lines: economic, environmental and social, and where women play a generative role in making communities and the economy dynamic and empathetic.





The WOBIS partners developed the curricula for the training resources outlining what are the training objectives, outputs and modes of use of the WOBIS modules. The modules are divided into two blocks:

BLOCK 1:

- Module 1: Self-esteem
- Module 2: Interpersonal communication
- Module 3: Assertiveness, expressing one's needs and managing stress and other emotions
- Module 4: Organizing one's time and planning for the future

BLOCK 2:

- Module 1: Entrepreneurship in rural areas current challenges
- Module 2: Sources of obtaining and financing investments in rural areas
- Module 3: Creative entrepreneurship

3rd Transnational Meeting of Partners
